Ramthakur College shall focus on overall quality development of students. The college strongly promotes and favours interdisciplinary courses. As the college is affiliated to Tripura Central University, we follow the course structure designed by the university. NEP-2020 is adopted by the university as hence by the college from the year 2023. The college offers Interdisciplinary courses in a wide variety of subjects like Bengali, English, Hindi, Kokborok, Pali, Sanskrit, Education, History, Political Science, Philosophy Economics, Physical Education, Commerce interdisciplinary, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics Botany, Zoology, Human Physiology, Environmental Science and Information Technology. Student performance in these courses is assessed through various methods, including written exams, assignments, viva voce, and class

attendance.

As this college is affiliated to Tripura University (A Central University), it follows the guidelines laid down by the University. ABC ID is already assigned to each individual students of the college. The college provides necessary technical support to those students who face difficulties in generating ABC ID.
