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INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSION – 2018

The college offers programmes of study leading to the Degrees of Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) including Hons. In Arts/Science/Commerce, Each programme shall be of Six Semesters leading to either TDP-General or TDP Hons. Degree in respective programme under Tripura University (A Central University) -

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION :

1. Any student passing H.S.(+2) examination or its equivalent with at least four/five subjects including English from any recognized Board or Council shall be eligible for admission to the first semester of the above programme subject to availability of seats and restriction of combination of subjects, as detailed below.
2. For admission to B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com (Hons.) program of studies, the student has to secure in the qualifying examination, at least.
 - a) 40% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject in which he or she seeks Hons.

OR

 - b) 35% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in the subject in which he or she seeks Hons.
 - c) Anyone securing at least 50% marks in aggregate shall be eligible for taking Hons. in a subject which he or she did not study in the qualifying examination.
3. A candidate seeking admission to B.Com (Hons.) programme must fulfill the conditions as laid down below in addition to the above conditions, as mentioned in 2.
 - a) Has secured at least 40% marks in Mathematics at Madhyamik or its equivalent examination.

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b) Must have passed the qualifying examination with Mathematics / Business Mathematics.

OR

c) Must have passed in 2 (Two) Commerce papers in the qualifying examination.

4. A student shall not be allowed to take Hons. in a subject in which he or she has failed in the qualifying examination but subsequently passed as a compartmental candidate.
5. Any student may mention two subjects as his/her choice of Hons. Subject in order of preference in which case a photo-copy of the filled in form with a copy of marksheet of qualifying examination and SC/ST certificate (if applicable) has to be submitted.
6. Accountancy Group is offered for studying TDP and TDP (Hons.) in B.Com programmes .
7. Subjects under Group (A) cannot be taken with those of Group (B).
8. If a candidate desires to take Physics as Elective Subject he/she shall have to study Mathematics as one of the three Elective Subjects in the qualifying examination.
9. The following combinations of subjects are not allowed by the institution.
 - i) - Sanskrit with Pali / Hindi.
 - ii) History with Mathematics.
 - iii) English with Bengali / Kokborok.
 - iv) Philosophy with Economics.
 - v) Pali with Hindi.
 - vi) Bengali with Kokborok.
10. Subject taken as Hons. shall not be taken as an Elective subject.
11. Candidates seeking Hons. in Physics or Chemistry have to take Mathematics as an Elective Subject.

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12. A candidate shall have to pass subjects under column 'B' in the qualifying examination if he or she desires to take General / Hons. Course under column 'A'.

13. The Syllabi, Curriculum and attendance in classes for taking part in the Credit Based Six Semester Degree Programme shall strictly be as per Rules and Regulations of Tripura University.

INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING SUBMISSION OF FILLED-IN ADMISSION FORM

14. Candidates must submit self attested copies of the following documents along with the duly filled in application forms.
- Proof of date of Birth, ii) Marks sheet of Madhyamik / Equivalent Exam, iii) Caste certificates (SC/ST) and or PG certificate iv) Mark Sheet of last Qualifying examination,
 - Certificate of participation in Games and sports at National / State Level, vi) One copy of recent passport size photograph to be pasted on the form.

All certificates in original are to be produced for verification at the time of admission to the college. School Leaving Certificate (Original) is to be submitted to the college at time of admission.

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SYLLABI, CURRICULUM, ATTENDANCE AND EXAMINATION

The syllabi, curriculum and attendance in classes will be strictly as per rules and regulations of Tripura University to which the college is affiliated. A student must attend a minimum of 75% lectures delivered failing which he / she will not be eligible for getting any Govt. Scholarship.

FACILITIES FOR CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Institute encourages students to participate in N C C, N S S and various co-curricular activities. On every last Saturday of the month the College organizes cultural programme/interdisciplinary lecture programmes. NCC is the second line of defence.
